13 Pursuant to the Board's deliberations at its meeting of
14 October 4, 1995, noticed pursuant to Nevada's Open Meeting
15 Law,

16 THE BOARD HEREBY ORDERS AND DECLARES that a decision
17 regarding Complainant's request for an additional day to
18 present Mr. Shults' case (hearing presently scheduled for one
19 day, November 8, 1995) will be made upon timely receipt of a
20 list of the names and titles/positions of each witness which
21 Mr. Shults desires to have called to testify in his behalf
22 (including, pursuant to NAC 288.250, their qualifications and
23 a brief summary of their expected testimony). This list must
24 be received by the Board on or before Wednesday, October 18,
25 1995.

26 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND DECLARED that the parties take
27 judicial notice that, absent a showing of good cause, the
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1 Board is not inclined to grant additional time for the purpose
2 of hearing duplicative, superfluous and/or unnecessary
3 testimony, such as testimony to establish facts which are
4 subject to stipulation. Accordingly, the Board expects the
5 parties to make a good-faith effort during the pre-hearing
6 conference (scheduled for October 25, 1995), to limit their
7 witnesses to no more than ten (10) persons for each side, in
8 order to facilitate concluding the hearing in one day, as
9 presently scheduled.
