14 parties joint execution of the Election Agreement. The Tally of Ballots shows that a collective  
15 bargaining representative has been selected. No timely objections have been filed.

16 As authorized by NRS 288, it is certified that a majority of the valid ballots have been cast  
17 for the INTERNATIONAL UNION OF OPERATING ENGINEERS, LOCAL UNION NO. 3, and  
18 that it is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of the employees in the following  
19 appropriate unit:

20 UNIT: All regular full-time and part-time employees, including Per Diem employees, of the Mount  
21 Grant General Hospital Support Service Bargaining Unit comprised of CNA's including Ward  
22 Clerks, housekeeping including all janitorial/custodial personnel and dietary/food services  
23 employees.

24 In light of attempts having been made by this Board to obtain a stipulation to dismiss which  
25 attempts have been frustrated by counsel, and good cause appearing,

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1 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this Complaint is dismissed with each side to bear its own  
2 fees and costs.
