14 On December 1, 2003, Complainant ELKO COUNTY DEPUTY SHERIFF'S  
15 ASSOCIATION (hereafter "Association") filed a Prohibited Practices Complaint with the  
16 LOCAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEE-MANAGEMENT RELATIONS BOARD (hereafter  
17 "Board").

18 On February 23, 2004, Respondents ELKO COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE and ELKO  
19 COUNTY (hereafter "County") filed their Answer to Prohibited Practices Complaint.

20 On August 18, 2004, both the Association and the County filed a Stipulation to Defer  
21 Proceedings.

22 The Board deliberated on said stipulation on September 21, 2004, noticed in accordance  
23 with Nevada's Open Meeting Law. Based upon the Board's deliberations,

24 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the matter is deferred pending the outcome of the  
25 ongoing arbitration.

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
1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within thirty (30) days upon completion of the
