22 No response to the Complaint has been received from Respondent NYE COUNTY LAW  
23 ENFORCEMENT ASSOCIATION (hereafter "Association").

24 The Board held deliberations on said motions on September 21, 2004, noticed in  
25 accordance with Nevada's Open Meeting Law. Based upon the Board's deliberations,

26 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the County's Motion for Summary Judgment is denied  
27 and the Motion for a More Definite Statement is granted.




1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Rennie shall file an Amended Complaint in
