20 On September 22, 2004, Complainant CARSON CITY FIRE FIGHTERS
21 ASSOCIATION, INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF FIRE FIGHTERS, LOCAL 2251
22 (hereafter "Association") filed a complaint before the LOCAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEE-
23 MANAGEMENT RELATIONS BOARD (hereafter "Board") against Respondent CARSON
24 CITY ("City"). The City filed a Motion to Dismiss Verified Complaint or For Deferral of
25 Proceedings. The Association filed an opposition and the District filed its reply.

26 On January 5, 2005, the Board entered an order denying the Motion to Dismiss and
27 granting the Motion for Deferral.

28 On January 24, 2005, the Association and the City filed a Stipulation to extend the time
for the City to file a responsive pleading.

On February 22, 2005, the Association and the City filed a Stipulation that this matter be
dismissed with prejudice.


The Board held deliberations on March 30, 2005, noticed in accordance with Nevada's
Open Meeting Law. Based upon the Board's deliberations,


1 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this matter be dismissed with prejudice with each party
