18 On July 7, 2005, Petitioner RENO-SPARKS CONVENTION AND VISITORS
19 AUTHORITY ("RSCVA") filed a Petition Challenging the Sufficiency of Application for
20 Recognition and Request for Election.

21 On July 15, 2005, Respondent INTERNATIONAL ALLIANCE OF THEATRICAL
22 STAGE EMPLOYEES, MOVING PICTURE TECHNICIANS, ARTISTS AND ALLIED
23 CRAFTS OF THE UNITED STATE, ITS TERRITORIES AND CANADA, LOCAL 363
("IATSE") filed its opposition.

24 On July 20, 2005, RSCVA filed a Notice of Withdrawal of Petition stating that they have
25 voluntarily recognized IATSE as the exclusive bargaining representative for the AV Department
26 at the Convention Center.

27 The Board held deliberations on this matter on July 21, 2005, noticed in accordance with
28 Nevada's Open Meeting Law. Based upon the Board's deliberations,
