
Based upon the orders as mentioned herein, and good cause appearing therefore,

The parties are to submit their respective briefs within thirty (30) days of the service of this order regarding that specific issue. In addition to the legal arguments to be contained within the briefs, references should be made to the exhibits and/or evidence previously provided to this Board during the administrative hearing and used by the Board in the formation of its prior findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order. If an additional evidentiary hearing is


1 necessary for the consideration of additional evidence, the parties are to include such a request
