
26 On October 24, 2006, a complaint alleging prohibited labor practices was filed by Judith
27 Carpenter ("Carpenter"), against the Respondents above-named, with the Local Government
28 Employee-Management Relations Board ("Board"). The Certificate of Mailing on the Complaint
indicated that the Complaint was mailed, but does not indicate that it was mailed by certified
mail, return receipt requested. On January 3, 2007, Carpenter filed a Motion to Default the
Respondents as an Answer had not been timely filed. Respondents alleged they did not receive
the Complaint. Respondents filed an Opposition to the Motion, and thereafter, Carpenter filed a
document entitled "Vexatious Litigation: Respondents' Latest Weapon for Constructive
Discharge."


1 The Motion was noticed for deliberations by the Board on the 13th day of March, 2007,
