14 On the 12th day of February, 2008, this matter came on for discussion and deliberations
15 by the Local Government Employee-Management Relations Board ("Board"), noticed pursuant
16 to NRS and NAC chapters 288, NRS chapter 233B, and Nevada's open meeting laws.

17 On October 24, 2007, this Board entered an order that this matter would be deferred until
18 "Banks obtained counsel to represent her in this matter, or the NERC rules on the complaint filed
19 by Banks, or the federal court decides the motion to dismiss pending before it, whichever occurs
20 first." On December 17, 2007, this Board entered an order that the NERC/EEOC dismissed the
21 matter before it pertaining to Karen Banks ("Banks") and the Federal Court dismissed Banks'
22 lawsuit. Although Banks did not indicate counsel had been retained, the Board ordered that the
23 parties file their pre-hearing statements within twenty days pursuant to NAC 288.250.
24 Respondent, Clark County Department of Aviation, filed its pre-hearing statement with a
25 "Motion to Dismiss." Banks filed a document entitled "RE: Order, Dated December 18, 2007"
26 on December 31, 2007. Thereafter, on February 5, 2008, Banks filed a document entitled
27 "Request for Additional Time" indicating that she needed more time to obtain representation.

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
