17 On June 6, 2007, a complaint was filed with the Local Government Employee-
18 Management Relations Board ("Board") by Complainant, International Association of Fire
19 Fighters, Local 1908 ("Association"), regarding the alleged failure to include certain job
20 classifications within the Association's bargaining units. An Answer was filed by Clark County
21 and the Clark County Fire Department (collectively, "Fire Department"). Thereafter the parties
22 filed their respective pre-hearing statements.

23 On September 20, 2007, the Board entered an order indicating its discretion not to hear
24 the instant matter as it found "insufficient evidence of a violation of NRS chapter 288" for which
25 a hearing was warranted. The Association then sought a writ of mandamus from the Eighth
26 Judicial District Court; and as a result of that writ, the instant matter was scheduled for hearing
27 before the Board, which hearing was to commence on Tuesday, July 29, 2008 and continue
28 through July 31, 2008.


On July 22, 2008, the Association filed a motion to continue the administrative hearing
and set forth good cause to support the request for continuance. There was no opposition to the

1 motion. Based thereon, this motion was noticed for consideration and decision by the Board on
2 the 29th day of July, 2008, pursuant to the provisions of NRS and NAC chapters 288, as well as
3 NRS chapter 233B and Nevada's Open Meeting laws.

4 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the hearing in this matter is continued, and the parties
5 are instructed to work with the Board's staff to reschedule this matter to be heard at the earliest
6 opportunity.
