21 On April 2, 2008, an Order was issued by this Board directing all parties to file pre-
22 hearing statements pursuant to NAC 288.250 within twenty (20) days from the date of the Order.
23 The Association filed a motion seeking permission to late file its Answer. No pre-hearing
24 statements were received from any of the parties to this matter.


25 Pursuant to NAC 288.375, the Complainant in this matter is not prosecuting his case in a

27 THEREUPON, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this matter is dismissed in its entirety, with each




1 party to bear their own fees and costs incurred herein. Because of this dismissal, the Board need
