14 On the 23rd day of June, 2008, this matter came on before the State of Nevada, Local  
15 Government Employee-Management Relations Board ("Board") for deliberations and  
16 discussions. The matter was duly noticed pursuant to NRS and NAC chapters 288, NRS chapter  
17 233B, and Nevada's Open Meeting laws.

18 The complaint in this matter was filed by the Regional Transportation Commission of  
19 Southern Nevada ("RTC") against Service Employees International Union Local 1107 ("SEIU")  
20 February 28, 2008. The certificate of mailing reveals that the complaint was served on SEIU via  
21 U. S. certified mail, return receipt requested. That receipt was not filed with this Board, nor has  
22 SEIU filed an answer in this matter. An answer, however, is discretionary pursuant to NAC  
23 288.220(1).

24 Inasmuch as the proof of service was not filed with the Board, IT IS HEREBY  
25 ORDERED that the RTC file proof of service, i.e., the return receipt, with this Board within ten  
26 (10) days of service of this order.


27 At the expiration of that ten-day period of time, if service was indeed perfected, both  
28 SEIU and the RTC are HEREBY ORDERED to file pre-hearing statements within twenty (20)


1 days thereafter pursuant to NAC 288.250. Failure to comply with this Order may result in
