If a scheduled hearing is postponed or canceled with notice of more than 15 business days but less than 3 calendar months, one-half the per diem fee for each day of hearing shall be charged if another matter cannot be set in its place.**Travel Time:** No charge for travel time of 2 hours or less. One-half of per diem fee for any portion of a travel day up to four hours, and a full per diem fee for travel time that exceeds four hours.
