1. Call to Order

2. Public Comment

3. Case 2015-034

Las Vegas Peace Officers Association v. City of Las Vegas

The Panel deliberated on what actions to take on the remand of District Court case number A-17-751972-J, which was pursuant to a Petition for Judicial Review filed by the Las Vegas Peace Officers Association. Upon motion, the Panel unanimously decided to issue an order on remand, striking the language of "actual and specific", where applicable, pursuant to the District Court's order, and stating in the order on remand the following: "Indeed, the Board does not find compelling or credible that LVPOA would make significant concessions in exchange for a cap when none previously existed. Complainant failed to show that the full cost of union leave time was paid for by LVPOA or was offset by the value of concessions made by LVPOA in the negotiation of an agreement with the City."
