PRELIMINARY MATTERS

1. Call to Order

The *en banc* meeting was called to order by Chair Brent C. Eckersley, Esq., on Wednesday, June 6, 2018 at 8:10 a.m.

2. Public Comment

No public comment was offered.

3. Case 2017-030

Teamsters Local 14 v. Town of Pahrump

The Board certified the election results pursuant to the numbers as found on the Tally of Ballots, thus declaring that a majority of the bargaining unit wanted to be represented by Teamsters Local 14 as opposed to the option of no union. Accordingly, the Board declared Teamsters Local 14 to be the exclusive bargaining agent for the bargaining unit of the Town of Pahrump blue collar employees.

4. Random Assignment of Cases to a Hearing Panel

The Panel randomly assigned the cases which had previously been granted a hearing to the various hearing panels as follows:

Panel A

2018-005, Police Administrators Association of the Clark County School District v. Clark County School District

Panel B

2018-006, Charles Ebarb v. Clark County & Clark County Water Reclamation District

Panel C

2017-028, Elizabeth Bantz v. Washoe County School District

2018-003, University Medical Center of Southern Nevada v. SEIU, Local 1107

Panel D

2018-007, Jarod Jackson v. Clark County

Panel E

2018-001, Ruben Murillo v. Clark County Education Association

The Board also randomly selected Case 2018-012, Nye County Management Employees Association v. Nye County, to be the first backup case and 2018-008, Travis Crumrine v. Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department to be the second backup case.

Each backup case would then be slotted into an existing panel, should the case originally assigned to that panel settle, provided there is at least one month remaining prior to the panel meeting. The first backup case would be slotted first.


5. Additional Period of Public Comment
