**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT  
EMPLOYEE-MANAGEMENT RELATIONS BOARD**  
**(Meeting No. 18-07)**

An *en banc* meeting of the Local Government Employee-Management Relations Board, properly noticed and posted pursuant to the Nevada Open Meeting Law, was held on Thursday, July 12, 2018, at the hour of 8:00 a.m., at the Office of the Employee-Management Relations Board, 3300 West Sahara Avenue, Suite 260, Las Vegas, Nevada 89102.

The Agenda:

**1. Call to Order**

The *en banc* meeting was called to order by Chair Brent C. Eckersley, Esq., on Thursday, July 12, 2018 at 8:00 a.m.

**2. Public Comment**

No public comment was offered.

**3. Approval of the Minutes**

The Board approved the minutes as presented for the meetings April 10, 2018 and June 6, 2018.

**4. Appointment of Board Member and Oath of Office**

Chair Eckersley acknowledged that the Governor had reappointed Philip E. Larson to the Board for another four-year term. Board Member Larson acknowledged that he had signed and returned the oath of office. Commissioner Snyder then gave the oath of office to Mr. Larson.

**5. Election of Chair and Vice Chair**

Pursuant to NRS 288.090, and upon motion, the Board elected Brent C. Eckersley, Esq. as Chairman and Sandra Masters as Vice Chairman for fiscal year 2019.

**6. Case 2018-015**

**Teamsters Local 14 v. Las Vegas-Clark County Library District**

Commissioner Snyder stated that the parties had waived the hearing and had agreed to conduct an election to determine whether the part-time employees of the Respondent wish to be recognized as a separate bargaining unit, to be represented by Teamsters Local 14. The Board reviewed the various election plan documents and approved them as presented, noting that Deputy Attorney General Bordelove had requested that a clause be inserted into the order, stating that the parties had agreed to the election plan. He further stated that he had received written confirmation from the parties that this change was acceptable to them.

**7. Case 2018-002**

**Education Support Employees Association v. Clark County School District & Vance**

The Board deliberated on Respondent Vance's Motion to Dismiss First Amended Complaint, and upon motion granted Respondent's motion, noting that including Vance as a Respondent was redundant.

**8. Report of the Deputy Attorney General**

Deputy Attorney General Donald Bordelove provided an oral report on the various matters pending in court. In particular, he mentioned that the EMRB prevailed on a motion for a preliminary injunction filed by the Southern Nevada Health District in the case over whether three employees should be excluded from the bargaining unit. He also mentioned that oral argument had been held before the Nevada Supreme Court on June 13<sup>th</sup> in the Teamsters-ESEA election case.

**9. Additional Period of Public Comment**

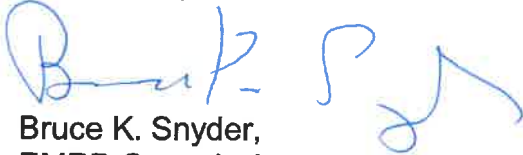
Michael Urban stated that he is to be served on the case involving Charles Ebarb, that is currently pending before the EMRB, but that he is not the attorney of record but

rather the attorney of record is Adam Levine. He then inquired as to what should be done when he is served. Commissioner Snyder responded, stating that he should forward a courtesy copy to the EMRB and that we would then determine what should be done.

There being no additional business to conduct, Chair Eckersley adjourned the meeting.
