7. Report of the Deputy Attorney General

Deputy Attorney General Donald Bordelove provided an oral report on the various matters pending in court. He specifically mentioned that the Nevada Supreme Court had issued a decision in the Deputy Marshals case, holding that the appeal by the Deputy Marshals had not been timely filed. Three justices dissented, stating that the appeal had been timely filed and that they believed that the decision of the EMRB and of the District Court should have been affirmed.

There being no additional business to conduct, Presiding Officer Eckersley adjourned the meeting.
