4. Case 2018-005

6. Consolidated Case 2017-020

Juvenile Justice Supervisors Association & Juvenile Justice Probation Officers Association v. Clark County

The Panel deliberated on the hearing previously held, and upon motion, (1) ruled in favor of the Respondent with respect to Complainant JJSA in that JJSA failed to show it had paid the full cost of union leave time or had offset the cost by the value of any concessions; (2) ruled in favor of the Respondent with respect to Complainant JJPOA in that JJPOA failed to show it had paid the full cost of union leave time or had offset the cost by the value of any concessions; and (3) that there was no bad faith found on the part of the County.
