19 **JOINT STATUS REPORT**

20 Complainant, LAS VEGAS POLICE PROTECTIVE ASSOCIATION, by and through its
21 attorney of record, David Roger, Esq; Respondent, the City of Las Vegas (hereinafter "City" or
22 "CLV"), by and through its attorney of record, Morgan Davis, Esq. hereby submit their Joint
23 Status Report pursuant to the Commissioner's email dated July 19, 2023 in the above referenced
24 matter.

1 This case was stayed by the Board on November 5, 2021. The Association has filed two
2 complaints for declaratory relief in District Court.

3 In case no. A-21-835584-C, the Court is asked to decide whether the collective bargaining
4 agreement requires the City to pay longevity benefits to officers.
5

6 A related case was filed in case no. A-21-845029-C, which asks the court to determine
7 whether the collective bargaining agreement allows the City to refuse to arbitrate longevity
8 benefit claims when the City believes the grievances are untimely. This case was consolidated
9 with A-21-835584-C (“Consolidated District Court Case”).
10

11 Since the last report, the parties have participated in discovery in the Consolidated District
12 Court Case and recently the LVPPA filed a motion to extend the discovery cutoff date to allow
13 for an additional deposition to be taken. That motion also seeks a continuance of the trial date.
14 The current trial date is June 24, 2024, on a five-week stack, but is subject to change if the motion
15 to continue is granted.

17 Additionally, the original arbitration hearing, which included the first grievants, was
18 vacated pending negotiations. The parties have been unable to resolve the matter and a new date
19 has not been set.
