16	In a telephone conference meeting held on March 29,
17	1993, pursuant to Nevada's Open Meeting Law, the Board
18	determined, pursuant to NAC 288.110(8), that:
19	(1) The issues regarding the challenged ballots effecting the results of the bargaining unit
20	electing the results of the bargaining unit election held March 10 and 11, 1993, can be resolved without a hearing;
21	(2) The challenged ballot cast by Karalee Gunter
22	(because she had submitted a resignation dated March 3, 1993, to be effective March 17, 1993)
23	should be counted [see NLRB vs. General Tube Co., 331 F.2d 751, 56 LRRM 2161 (CA 6, 1964); Ely &
24	Walker, 151 NLRB 636, 58 LRRM 1513 (1965); Reidbord Bros. Co., 99 NLRB 127, 30 LRRM 1047
25	(1952).]; and
26	(3) The challenged ballot cast by Esperanza Marin (because she signed it) is null and void and
27	should not be counted [see <u>George K. Garrett Co.</u> , 120 NLRB 484, 41 LRRM 1519 (1958); <u>Eagle Tron</u>
90	TO MIND 404, AT THOUS TOTA (TAGE) TOTA

Works, 117 NLRB 1053, 39 LRRM 1379 (1957); Burlington Mills Corp., 56 NLRB 365, 14 LRRM 148 (1944)].

The Board hereby ORDERS that the parties immediately contact the Board's Commissioner and reach agreement to a time, date and location for opening the envelope containing the challenged ballot of Karalee Gunter. If said ballot is determined to have been cast in favor of representation by Elko County Employees Association, resulting in a tie vote (85 for and 85 against), the Board further ORDERS that another election be held, pursuant to NAC 288.110. Said election will be conducted under the supervision of the Board's Commissioner within forty-five (45) days from the date of this Order, pursuant to NRS 288.160(4) and NAC 288.110. Linguistic assistance will be provided by the parties and a bilingual ballot will be used.

If Karalee Gunter's ballot is determined to have been cast representation by Elko County against Employees Association, resulting in 86 votes being cast against representation and 84 for representation, the parties will be notified that the election of March 10 and 11, 1993, failed to provide a basis for certification of the Association as the exclusive bargaining agent for certain employees of Elko General Hospital.

The Board's decision in this case is solely to resolve a situation which arose as a result of the particular facts and circumstances surrounding the instant case. The Board is concerned about the lack of linguistic assistance and the lack

of a bilingual ballot in the election of March 10 and 11, 1993. Accordingly, the Board's decision in the instant case must not be construed as grounds for holding a run-off or rerun election in every instance when a tie vote occurs in the future.
