This Complaint was filed on September 10, 1993. On three previous occasions, hearing dates were agreed upon by all parties and scheduled by the Board. Two of those dates were subsequently continued due to requests of the Complainant (one was at the Board's necessity). The currently scheduled dates of November 15 and 16, 1994, will not be again continued to accommodate Complainant.

In a Pre-Hearing conference conducted by the Board's Commissioner on September 9, 1994, and at the request of Complainant's counsel, Complainant's counsel was given until October 10, 1994, to file a new pre-hearing brief and a list of exhibits. A schedule for responsive briefs was also agreed upon. As of October 24, 1994, neither Complainant's brief nor his list of exhibits has been filed. Additionally, the

1 parties agreed to meet and stipulate to the issues for
2 hearing, stipulate to exhibits, and identify whether
3 subpoenaed witnesses or documents will be necessary.
4 Respondent has filed his list of exhibits and his proposed
5 issues for hearing. Complainant has filed nothing and no
6 stipulations between counsel have been forthcoming.

7 In view of all the above, the following pre-hearing
8 procedures will be in effect and enforced in this case:

- 10 1. No further briefing will be accepted from this date
11 forward. Complainant was afforded an opportunity
12 to file a brief, but did not avail himself of it.
 - 13 2. Complainant will file with the Board Commissioner a
14 list of his proposed witnesses and exhibits by 5:00
15 PM, October 28, 1994.
 - 16 3. Counsel for both parties will meet and stipulate to
17 the Board Commissioner in writing, by 5:00 PM
18 November 4, 1994, to the following: (1) the
19 specific issues in dispute at the upcoming hearing;
20 (2) exhibits not in dispute; (3) document
21 production requiring subpoenas; (4) witnesses who
22 will be available for testimony by both parties and
23 witnesses who will require subpoenas. No request
24 for subpoenas will be considered after that date.
 - 25 4. Failure of either party to comply with the above
26 procedures, necessary to expedite the hearing
27 process, may be grounds for sanctions up to and
28 including cancellation of the hearing and dismissal
of the complaint.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the parties be governed as set
forth herein-above.
