ORDER OF DISMISSAL

NORTH LAS VEGAS POLICE OFFICER ASSOCIATION

Pursuant to the Board's deliberations at its meeting of November 4, 1998. noticed in accordance with Nevada's Open Meeting Law, on the Motion to Dismiss filed by Respondent The North Las Vegas Police Officer's Association, Local 41 ("Association"), the Board decides and rules as follows:

On July 22, 1998, complainant Joseph E. Austin ("Austin") filed his Complaint with the Board. In his Complaint, Austin challenges, among other things, the Association's denial of rights accorded to active members of the Association. The Association is entitled to a dismissal in this action.

The Association notified Austin that, as he elected to receive pay and was being accorded medical benefits of a retired member, he was being classified as a retired member. As a retired member, Austin is not a "local government employee" as defined in NRS 288.050. Under NAC 288.030, only a local government employee may be deemed a Complainant. Therefore, as an individual who is not a local government employee, Austin has no standing to bring a complaint and the Board is entitled to dismiss this complaint pursuant to NAC 288.210(1).

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, for the reason set forth above, that the Association's Motion to Dismiss is granted, and Austin's Complaint is dismissed with prejudice.

Each side to bear its own attorney's fees and costs in the subject matter disposed of by this Order.
