On January 24, 2000, a Petition for Rehearing was filed by the Operating Engineers, Local No. 3 of the International Union of Operating Engineers, AFL-CIO (hereafter "Union") concerning the Board's January 11, 2000, Order No. 458, denying the Union's request for recognition of a separate bargaining unit of certain employees of the Truckee Meadows Water Reclamation Facility separate from the general bargaining unit, finding that the current wall-to-wall representation by the Union of the City of Sparks' employees is appropriate and that the community of interest of all employees would be best achieved through the denial of the request for a separate bargaining unit.

Pursuant to the Board's deliberation at its meeting of February 8, 2000, noticed in accordance with Nevada's Open Meeting Law, the Board decides and rules as follows:

Pursuant to NAC 288.360(1), the Petition for Rehearing was timely filed.

BASED UPON the arguments raised in the Petition, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Petition for Rehearing is DENIED.
