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14 On or about January 21, 2000, Complainant International Union of Operating Engineers,  
15 Local Union No. 3 (hereafter "Union") filed a complaint in the above-referenced matter alleging  
16 prohibited practices by the City of Sparks (hereafter "City").

17 The City filed a motion to dismiss the complaint on February 2, 2000. Pursuant to NAC  
18 288.240(4), a response by the Union was due ten (10) days from the date of service of the motion.  
19 No response was filed; and the City filed a request to submit the motion for decision on February 22,  
20 2000.

21 This matter was scheduled for deliberations pursuant to the Nevada Open Meeting Law and  
22 the Board conducted such deliberations on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2000.

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1 Based upon such deliberations, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the motion to dismiss is  
2 hereby GRANTED, dismissing the complaint since no response was filed by the Union.
