14 On July 10, 2000, Complainant RENO POLICE PROTECTIVE ASSOCIATION
15 (hereafter "Association") filed a complaint with the LOCAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEE-
16 MANAGEMENT RELATIONS BOARD (hereafter "Board").

17 On July 31, 2000, Respondent RENO POLICE DEPARTMENT and CITY OF RENO
18 (hereafter "City") filed a Motion for Deferral of Proceedings. No opposition was received to the
19 motion from the Association. The Board entered an Order (Item #476) on September 20, 2000,
20 granting said motion.

21 After numerous exchanges of correspondence between this office and the Association,
22 the City filed a Motion to Dismiss. The City stated that they had attempted to execute a
23 stipulation but the Association has refused to execute the same. No opposition has been received
24 from the Association.

25 The Board deliberated on said motion on June 2, 2004, noticed in accordance with
26 Nevada's Open Meeting Law. Based upon the Board's deliberations,

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1 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Motion to Dismiss is granted and the Association is
2 hereby ordered to pay the City \$500.00 in attorney fees for the filing of said motion.
