 19 be denied, and that the Motion for a More Definite Statement be granted.

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
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1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Complainants shall amend their Complaint within

5 particular acts and the name of persons involved" and, pursuant to NAC 288.200(1)(d), cite the
6 "legal authority under which the complaint is made," including identifying the specific alleged
7 prohibited practice(s) as set forth in NRS 288.270.
