10 On January 12, 2001, the LAS VEGAS METROPOLITAN POLICE DEPARTMENT
11 (hereafter "LVMPD") lodged correspondence with the Local Government Employee-Management
12 Relations Board (hereafter "Board"), requesting "written permission from the [Board] to withdraw
13 recognition from the PPA as the employee organization representing the interests of Corrections
14 Captains, Lieutenants, and Sergeants. The LVMPD further requests a determination by the [Board]
15 as to when the change in representation will occur if permission is granted."

16 The Board deliberated on this request on January 30, 2001, noticed in accordance with
17 Nevada's Open Meeting Law. Based upon LVMPD's correspondence of January 12, 2001, and good
18 cause appearing therefore,

19 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the request for "written permission" from this Board to
20 "withdraw recognition from the PPA as the employee organization representing the interests of
21 Corrections Captains, Lieutenants and Sergeants" is denied at this time, without prejudice, based
22 upon insufficiency of evidence.

23 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that LVMPD, the Police Managers and Supervisors
24 Association, and the Police Protective Association file briefs in support of or against this withdrawal
25 request, with supporting documentation, within twenty (20) days from this order. Supporting
26 documentation should include, but is not limited to, a copy of the parties' current collective




