10 On January 12, 2001, the LAS VEGAS METROPOLITAN POLICE DEPARTMENT
11 (hereafter "LVMPD") lodged correspondence with the Local Government Employee-Management
12 Relations Board (hereafter "Board"), requesting "written permission from the [Board] to withdraw
13 recognition from the PPA as the employee organization representing the interests of Corrections
14 Captains, Lieutenants, and Sergeants. The LVMPD further requests a determination by the [Board]
15 as to when the change in representation will occur if permission is granted."

16 The Board deliberated on this request on January 30, 2001, and denied the LVMPD's request
17 to "withdraw recognition from the PPA as the employee organization representing the interests of
18 Corrections Captains, Lieutenants and Sergeants."

19 Briefs were filed by the parties to this action and on March 6, 2001, noticed in accordance
20 with Nevada's Open Meeting Law, the Board deliberated on whether to hear this matter.


21 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that this matter be set for hearing for the time period of April
22 10 through 12, 2001, commencing immediately following the hearing in Case No. A1-045689 at the
23 offices of the Local Government Employee-Management Relations Board located at 2501 E. Sahara
24 Avenue, Suite 203, Las Vegas, Nevada. It should be noted that the hearing on Case No. A1-045700,
25 styled "In the Matter of the Request of Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department to Withdraw
26 Recognition of Police Protective Association as Representative for Certain Members, namely Police
27 Officers I and II, and Corrections Officers I and II" will be heard immediately thereafter.


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
1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that supplemental briefs shall be filed within ten (10) days of
