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18 On July 5, 2001, Complainant LAS VEGAS POLICE PROTECTIVE ASSOCIATION
19 METRO, INC. (hereafter "LVPPA") filed a Complaint for Declaratory Relief with the Local
20 Government Employee-Management Relations Board (hereafter "Board") against the CITY OF
21 LAS VEGAS (hereafter "City"). On July 25, 2001, the City filed their Answer.

22 On August 9, 2001, the incumbent Las Vegas Peace Officers Association (hereafter
23 "LVPOA") filed a Petition to Intervene. No opposition has been received from any party.

24 On August 20, 2001, LVPPA filed a Pre-Hearing Statement.


25 The Board deliberated on the Complaint for Declaratory Relief and the Petition to
26 Intervene on September 19, 2001, noticed in accordance with Nevada's Open Meeting Law.
27 Based upon the documents filed to date and good cause appearing,

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
1 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Petition to Intervene is granted and the LVPOA and
