On October 10, 2001, Complainant BRUCE KIRBY filed a complaint with the Local Government Employee-Management Relations Board (hereafter "Board").


On November 30, 2001, Respondents RENO POLICE DEPARTMENT and CITY OF RENO filed a Motion to Dismiss. No opposition has been received.


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the motion to dismiss is granted without prejudice with each side to bear its own costs and fees.
