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13 On November 2, 2001, Complainant RENO POLICE PROTECTIVE ASSOCIATION
14 filed a complaint with the Local Government Employee-Management Relations Board (hereafter
15 "Board"). The Board entered an order on February 13, 2002, ordering the City to file an answer.

16 On February 21, 2002, Respondents RENO POLICE DEPARTMENT and CITY OF
17 RENO filed an answer and a Motion for Deferral of Proceedings. Representations were made
18 that the Complainant would not file an opposition to a deferral order.

19 The Board deliberated on the motion on March 19, 2002, noticed in accordance with
20 Nevada's Open Meeting Law. Based upon Respondents' motion and Complainant's oral
21 representations to the Commissioner of the Board,

22 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the motion for deferral is granted.

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
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
1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties are to report back to the Board within thirty
