14 On January 24, 2002, Complainant RENO POLICE PROTECTIVE ASSOCIATION  
15 filed a complaint with the Local Government Employee-Management Relations Board (hereafter  
16 "Board").

17 On February 21, 2002, Respondents RENO POLICE DEPARTMENT and CITY OF  
18 RENO filed an answer and a Motion for Deferral of Proceedings. Representations were made  
19 that the Complainant would not file an opposition to a deferral order.

20 The Board deliberated on the motion on March 19, 2002, noticed in accordance with  
21 Nevada's Open Meeting Law. Based upon Respondents' motion and Complainant's oral  
22 representations to the Commissioner of the Board,

23 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the motion for deferral is granted with the parties to give  
24 a written status report 6 months from the date of this order.

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
1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties are to report back to the Board within thirty
