22 On January 29, 2002, Petitioner INTERNATIONAL BROTHERHOOD OF
23 TEAMSTERS, LOCAL 14, AFL-CIO (hereafter "Teamsters 14") filed an Application for Order
24 Convening an Administrative Hearing for the Purpose of Determining Whether to Conduct an
25 Election Pursuant to NRS 288.160, NAC 288.145 and NAC 288.146(1) and (2) with the Local
26 Government Employee-Management Relations Board (hereafter "Board") against the CLARK
27 COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT (hereafter "CCSD") and EDUCATION SUPPORT

2 to Dismiss both Case No. A1-045724 and the counterclaim in the above-referenced case.


3 The Board deliberated on said stipulation on October 16, 2002, noticed in accordance
