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16 On May 5, 2003, Complainant STEVEN B. KILGORE (hereinafter "Kilgore") filed a
17 complaint with the LOCAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEE-MANAGEMENT RELATIONS
18 BOARD (hereinafter "Board") and filed an amended complaint on August 7, 2003.

19 On September 11, 2003, Kilgore filed a motion for preliminary injunction. Respondent
20 CITY OF HENDERSON (hereafter "City") filed an opposition and Respondent HENDERSON
21 POLICE OFFICERS ASSOCIATION (hereafter "Association") filed a response on September
22 22, 2003. Kilgore filed his reply on September 23, 2003.

23 The Board deliberated on the Kilgore's motion on September 24, 2003, noticed in
24 accordance with Nevada's Open Meeting Law. Based upon the deliberations,

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1 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Motion for Preliminary Injunction is granted.
2 Kilgore has presented a basis for the injunction and shown a probability of success and
3 irreparable harm. Pursuant to NRS 288.110 (2), the City is ordered to maintain status quo ante as
4 of September 7, 2003 (Kilgore having been terminated on September 8, 2003) until an
5 administrative decision is issued herein.
