On October 28, 2003, Judith L. Carpenter (hereafter "Carpenter") filed a complaint with the Local Government Employee-Management Relations Board (hereafter "Board") against Rosemary Vassiliadis, Doris Diaz, Bill Mein, Christine Santiago, and Kathleen Kirwur (hereafter collectively "Supervisors"). On January 7, 2004, the Board ordered Carpenter to file a more specific amended complaint. That Amended Complaint was filed on February 2, 2004 and contained a Request for Summary or Declaratory Judgment.

On February 4, 2004, Louis Chachere, a concerned citizen, filed a Petition to Intervene, The Supervisors opposed the Petition, and Mr. Chachere filed his Reply on or about February 17. 2004. Carpenter again requested injunctive relief on February 4, 2004, which was opposed by the Supervisors on February 17, 2004.

On February 17, 2004, this Board entered an order, requiring Carpenter to file a First Amended Complaint, as well as denied other requests by Carpenter.

The Board held deliberations on March 2, 2004 on the aforementioned documents and/or pleadings noticed in accordance with Nevada's Open Meeting Law; and based thereon:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Mr. Chachere' Petition to Intervene is denied in that he has not complied in any manner with NAC 288.260 and any documents and/or pleadings filed by Mr. Chachere as an intervener or concerned citizen will not, therefore, be considered by this Board.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Carpenter's request for summary judgment and supplemental request for injunctive relief are denied as there has been no showing of irreparable harm and likelihood of success on the merits.
