13 On February 6, 2004, the Nevada Classified School Employees Association (hereinafter
14 "Association") requested recognition by the Pershing General Hospital and it's Board of Trustees
15 (hereinafter "Hospital"). The Association requested to be placed on the Board of Trustees'
16 agenda. When the Association was not placed on the Board of Trustees agenda, on February 12,
17 2004, the Association requested an election order of this Board.

18 The Board heard arguments of the parties concerning the Association's Request for an
19 Election on March 2, 2004. Thereafter, the Board held deliberations noticed in accordance with
20 Nevada's Open Meeting Law, and based thereon:

21 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that an administrative hearing be held on this request due to
22 the complexity of the matter as raised by the parties in their arguments.

23 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that prehearing statements be filed by the parties to this
24 matter pursuant to NAC 288.250 within twenty (20) days from the date of this order. As soon as
25 practicable, the Board's Commissioner shall arrange a prehearing conference pursuant to NAC
26 288.273, with emphasis to be placed on formulating and simplifying such issues as community
27 of interest of various employees, the various classifications of workers to be included in the


