15 On December 1, 2003, Complainant ELKO COUNTY DEPUTY SHERIFF'S
16 ASSOCIATION (hereafter "Association") filed a Prohibited Practices Complaint with the
17 LOCAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEE-MANAGEMENT RELATIONS BOARD (hereafter
18 "Board").

19 On February 23, 2004, Respondents ELKO COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE and ELKO
20 COUNTY (hereafter "County") filed their Answer to Prohibited Practices Complaint.

21 On August 18, 2004, both the Association and the County filed a Stipulation to Definitive
22 Proceedings.

23 The Board deliberated on said stipulation on September 21, 2004, noticed in accordance
24 with Nevada's Open Meeting Law. Based upon the Board's deliberations,

25 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the matter is deferred pending the outcome of the
26 ongoing arbitration.

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
1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within thirty (30) days upon completion of the
