15 On or about May 5, 2004, a complaint was filed with the Local Government Employee-
16 Management Relations Board ("Board") by Complainant, Service Employees International
17 Union, Local 1107, AFL-CIO ("Union"). An answer was filed by Clark County on or about Ju y
18 27, 2004. Thereafter, the parties filed their respective pre-hearing statements. On September 2
19 2004, this Board entered its order deferring this matter for exhaustion of the parties' contractual
20 grievance remedies. The Board further ordered that the parties provide a written status report
21 within six months from the order and provide a report to the Board within thirty (30) days after
22 completion of the grievance process. To date, neither the initial status report nor the subsequent
23 report has been filed with the Board by either party.

24 This matter was noticed for deliberations by the Board on the 12th day of March, 2007,
25 pursuant to the provisions of NRS and NAC Chapters 288, as well as NRS Chapter 233B and
26 Nevada's Open Meeting laws.

27 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the parties shall have to and including the 1st day of
28 April, 2007, within which to provide this Board with a status report. Should the

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1 parties fail to do so, this matter will be dismissed pursuant to NAC 288.373. Additionally, this
2 matter may be dismissed for want of prosecution pursuant to NAC 288.375.
