14 On October 21, 2003, Petitioner SERVICE EMPLOYEES INTERNATIONAL UNION,  
15 LOCAL 1107, AFL-CIO (hereafter "SEIU") filed a Petition for Unit Clarification with the  
16 LOCAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEE-MANAGEMENT RELATIONS BOARD (hereafter  
17 "Board"). On August 16, 2004, Respondent LAS VEGAS CONVENTION AND VISITORS  
18 AUTHORITY (hereafter "LVCVA") filed a Response (Answer) and Opposition to Petition for  
19 Unit Clarification.

20 On November 4, 2004, the Board issued an order (Item #594), instructing the  
21 Commissioner to meet with the parties and issue a recommendation.

22 The Commissioner met with the parties on November 18<sup>th</sup> and December 4<sup>th</sup> and on  
23 December 23<sup>rd</sup>, the recommendations were submitted to the parties.

24 On January 4, 2005, LVCVA filed an Agreement to Adopt Recommendation of  
25 Commissioner and Request Dismissal of Petition with Prejudice. The SEIU filed their  
26 Acceptance of Recommendation on January 12, 2005.

27 The Board held deliberations in the above-captioned matter on February 23, 2005,  
28 noticed in accordance with Nevada's Open Meeting Law. Based upon the Board's deliberations,


1 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Board adopts the Commissioner's recommendation
