15 On September 22, 2004, Complainant CARSON CITY FIRE FIGHTERS
16 ASSOCIATION, INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF FIRE FIGHTERS, LOCAL 2251
17 (hereafter "Association") filed a complaint before the LOCAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEE-
18 MANAGEMENT RELATIONS BOARD (hereafter "Board").

19 On October 11, 2004, Respondent CARSON CITY (hereafter "City") filed a Motion to
20 Dismiss Verified Complaint or For Deferral of Proceedings. The Association filed their
21 opposition on October 25, 2004 and on November 13, 2004, the City filed a response.

22 The Board held deliberations on January 5, 2005, noticed in accordance with Nevada's
23 Open Meeting Law. Based upon the Board's deliberations,

24 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Respondent's Motion to Dismiss the Complaint is
25 DENIED.


26 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that because application of the limited deferral doctrine
27 adopted by this Board in I.A.F.F. #731 v. City of Reno, Item No. 257, EMRB Case No. A1-
28 045466 (1991), appears warranted here, Respondent's Motion for Deferral is GRANTED. This

1 matter shall be and hereby is deferred for exhaustion of the parties' contractual grievance
2 arbitration remedies.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties are to provide a written status report to the
4 Board within six (6) months from the date of this order. The parties shall also provide a written
5 report to the Board within thirty (30) days of the completion of the grievance arbitration process,
6 by filing either an amended complaint or a stipulation to dismiss.
