17 On July 7, 2005, Petitioner RENO-SPARKS CONVENTION AND VISITORS
18 AUTHORITY ("RSCVA") filed a Petition Challenging the Sufficiency of Application
19 Recognition and Request for Election.

20 On July 15, 2005, Respondent INTERNATIONAL ALLIANCE OF THEATRICAL
21 STAGE EMPLOYEES, MOVING PICTURE TECHNICIANS, ARTISTS AND ALLIED
22 CRAFTS OF THE UNITED STATE, ITS TERRITORIES AND CANADA, LOCAL
23 ("IATSE") filed its opposition.

24 On July 20, 2005, RSCVA filed a Notice of Withdrawal of Petition stating that they h
25 voluntarily recognized IATSE as the exclusive bargaining representative for the AV Departm
26 at the Convention Center.
