17 & Remand” entered by the Nevada Supreme Court and the “”Order of Remand” entered by the
18 First Judicial District Court, Department I; and such deliberations and decision were noticed
19 pursuant to NRS and NAC chapters 288, NRS chapter 233B, and Nevada’s open meeting laws.

20 Based upon the orders as mentioned herein, and good cause appearing therefore,

21 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the parties are to submit briefs to this Board regarding
22 the costs, if any, of the Washoe County School District employees with respect to direct deposits
23 of salary and/or wages as well as any costs which will be incurred by the employees as a result of
24 the debit cards. The parties are to submit their respective briefs within thirty (30) days of the
25 service of this order regarding that specific issue. In addition to the legal arguments to be
26 contained within the briefs, references should be made to the exhibits and/or evidence previously
27 provided to this Board during the administrative hearing and used by the Board in the formation
28 of its prior findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order. If an additional evidentiary hearing is

1 necessary for the consideration of additional evidence, the parties are to include such a request
2 within their respective briefs.
