On the 7th day of December, 2006, the Local Government Employee-Management Relations Board ("Board") deliberated on the Petition for Leave to Intervene filed by the Washoe Education Support Professionals ("WESP"), the Motion to Dismiss Third Party Petition for Declaratory Ruling filed by WESP, and the Third Party's Petition for Declaratory Ruling filed by the Washoe County School District ("School District"); the deliberations were duly noticed for hearing pursuant to the provisions of NRS and NAC Chapter 288, as well as NRS Chapter 233B and Nevada's Open Meeting laws.

1 Complainants United We Stand Classified Employees/AFT, David Suttle, He
2 Mireles, Lynda Rhodes, and Antonio Thomas filed an opposition to the Motion for Leave
3 Intervene; WESP filed a "non-opposition" to the Motion to Intervene; the School District filed an
4 Opposition to the Motion to Dismiss; and reply points and authorities were filed in support of
5 Motion to Dismiss on or about September 27, 2006.

6 After due consideration and deliberations on the motions and other documents, it
7 **HEREBY ORDERED** that the motion to intervene be, and the same is, **GRANTED**.

8 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Motion to Dismiss Third Party Petition
9 Declaratory Ruling is **DENIED**; and the Petition for Declaratory Ruling will be considered
10 simultaneously with any hearing on the Prohibited Labor Practices Complaint filed by the
11 Complainants in this matter.
