15 On November 29, 2006, a complaint alleging prohibited labor practices was filed t
16 Nevada Classified School Employees Association, AFT/PSRP, Local 6181, AFL O
17 ("Association") against Truckee-Carson Irrigation District ("District") with the Local
18 Government Employee-Management Relations Board ("Board"). The District filed a Moti o
19 Dismiss. The Association then filed its Motion for a Continuance to File Opposition to M n
20 to Dismiss and Countermotion to Allow Discovery. The Association opposed the Moti o
21 Dismiss; and the District filed its reply points and authorities in support of the Moti to
22 Dismiss, as well as opposed the Motion for Discovery. The Association then filed its y
23 points and authorities in support of its request for discovery, and filed its Motion to Amen the
24 Complaint's Prayer for Relief. The District filed its opposition to the Motion to Amend P er
of the complaint.

25 The three Motions mentioned above were noticed for deliberations by the Board o e
26 13th day of March, 2007, pursuant to the provisions of NRS and NAC Chapters 288, as wc.. as
27 NRS Chapter 233B and Nevada's Open Meeting laws.


1 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Motion to Dismiss is denied without prejudice at the
