**ORDER**

14 The matter came on for discussion and deliberations by the Local Govern  
15 Employee-Management Relations Board ("Board") on the 2nd day of April, 2008, notic  
16 pursuant to NRS and NAC chapters 288, NRS chapter 233B, and Nevada's open meeting law:

17 On December 27, 2006, Ron Taylor ("Taylor") filed his complaint with the Bo ar  
18 alleging prohibited labor practices by the recognized employee organization, Clark Cou y  
19 Education Association ("Association"). Thereafter, various pleadings and documents were fi d  
20 by the parties.

21 On January 16, 2008, the Association filed a "Motion for Partial Summary Judgment. r  
22 Alternatively, Motion to Compel Joinder" of Clark County School District ("School District") s  
23 a Respondent in this action. The Association claims that this case should be dismissed ba d  
24 upon the ruling in Case No. A1-045899; and, in the event this matter is not dismissed as s  
25 judicata, the School District is a necessary party to this action. The School District opposed s  
26 joinder in this matter; and Taylor likewise filed an opposition on January 28, 2008. 1.. e  
27 Association filed its reply points and authorities supporting the motion.

1 Good cause appearing therefore, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the motion for partial  
2 summary judgment be, and the same is, GRANTED. The issue pertaining to the Memoranda of  
3 Understanding was resolved in Case No. A1-045899. Based upon this ruling, the issue of joining  
4 the School District in this matter appears moot.
