13 On the 12th day of February, 2008, this matter came on before the State of Nevada, Local
14 Government Employee-Management Relations Board ("Board"), for consideration and decision
15 pursuant to the provisions of NRS and NAC chapters 288, NRS chapter 233B, and Nevada
16 open meeting laws.


17 A complaint was filed in this matter by the Mesquite Police Officers Association
18 ("Association") on February 1, 2007, alleging prohibited practices. The City of Mesquite
19 ("City") filed an answer and counterclaim. Additionally, the City requested that this matter
20 be deferred, and the Association filed its motion to dismiss the City's counterclaim. The Board
21 entered its order on May 31, 2007, denying the request for deferral and denying the motion
22 to dismiss. After prehearing statements were filed, this matter was scheduled for hearing on
23 September 21, 2007, and a prehearing conference was also scheduled for September 7, 2007.
24 At the prehearing conference, the parties indicated their desire to resolve this case and further
25 indicated that it would advise the Board of any possible resolution. To date, the parties have not
26 provided this Board with any documents evidencing a resolution although the Board has made
27 various efforts to obtain any such documents evidencing a resolution.


1 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that based upon the parties' failure to prosecute this action in
