17 Government Employee-Management Relations Board ("Board"). The Clark County School  
18 District ("School District") filed a Motion to dismiss, which was opposed by Taylor on April  
19 2007. On April 24, 2007, the Clark County Education Association ("Association") filed a  
20 Motion to Dismiss, which was opposed by Taylor on May 7, 2007. The School District filed its  
21 reply points and authorities in support of its motion on May 3, 2007; and the Association filed its  
22 reply points and authorities in support of its motion on May 23, 2007.

23 This matter was duly noticed for deliberation and decision on May 30 and 31, 2007; such  
24 having been noticed pursuant to NRS chapter 288, NAC chapter 288, NRS chapter 233B, and  
25 Nevada's Open Meeting Laws; and based upon the documents filed,

26 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that both Motions to Dismiss are denied, without prejudice.


