14 On the 17th day of December, 2007, this matter, and in particular, the status report  
15 correspondence filed by counsel for Respondent Clark County Department of Aviat  
16 ("Department") came before this Local Government Employee-Management Relations Bo  
17 ("Board") for consideration and deliberation; such matter noticed for deliberations pursuant to  
18 NRS and NAC chapters 288, NRS chapter 233B, and Nevada's Open Meeting Laws.

19 Previously, this Board entered an Order dismissing portions of Banks' administrat  
20 complaint which were barred by the Board's statute of limitations and/or beyond this Boar  
21 jurisdiction. The portions of Banks' complaint pertaining to discrimination were not dismiss  
22 The Motion for Reconsideration or to Defer was denied as no additional evidence had be  
23 submitted which would alter this Board's prior ruling; and the Motion to Defer was grant  
24 This matter was deferred until Banks obtain counsel to represent her in this matter, or the NEI  
25 rules on the complaint filed by Banks, or the federal court decides the motion to dismiss pendi  
26 before it, whichever occurred first. According to the status report, the NERC/EEOC dismiss  
27 its matter based on its failure to complete the investigation within the mandatory time frame, a  
28 the federal action was dismissed, without prejudice, for Banks' failure to exhaust her


1 administrative remedies. It is unknown if the federal action has been refiled since the  
2 NERC/EEOC has entered its ruling.

3 Inasmuch as the federal court has dismissed the action pending before it, and the  
4 NERC/EEOC has closed its file in this matter, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the parties are to  
5 submit their pre-hearing statements pursuant to NAC 288.250 within twenty (20) days from the  
6 date of this Order.
