On June 6, 2007, a complaint was filed with the Local Government Employee Management Relations Board ("Board") by Complainant, International Association of Fire Fighters, Local 1908 ("Association"), regarding the alleged failure to include certain job classifications within the Association's bargaining units. An Answer was filed by Clark County and the Clark County Fire Department (collectively, "Fire Department"). Thereafter the parties filed their respective pre-hearing statements.

On September 20, 2007, the Board entered an order indicating its discretion not to hear the instant matter as it found "insufficient evidence of a violation of NRS chapter 288" for which a hearing was warranted. The Association then sought a writ of mandamus from the Eighth Judicial District Court, and as a result of that writ, the instant matter was scheduled for hearing before the Board, which hearing was to commence on Tuesday, July 29, 2008 and continue through July 31, 2008.

On July 22, 2008, the Association filed a motion to continue the administrative hearing and set forth good cause to support the request for continuance. There was no opposition to th


