16 On the 10th day of September, 2008, this matter came on before the State of Nevada  
17 Local Government Employee-Management Relations Board ("Board"), for consideration and  
18 decision pursuant to the provisions of NRS and NAC chapters 288, NRS chapter 233B, and  
19 Nevada's open meeting laws.

20 On January 29, 2008, the Nye County Law Enforcement Association ("Association")  
21 filed a complaint with the Board, alleging prohibited labor practices by Nye County and the Nye  
22 County Sheriff's office (collectively "Nye County"). On June 17, 2008, Richard P. McCann of  
23 the California Organization of Police & Sheriffs, Nevada Division ("COPS"), filed a Petition for  
24 permission to practice before the Board. No opposition was filed by Nye County; however, the  
25 petition was denied based upon NAC 288.278. The parties were ordered to file their respective  
26 prehearing statements.

27 Pursuant to the Board's order, the parties have requested additional time in which to file  
28 pre-hearing statements.

2 including the 1st day of November, 2008, in which to file prehearing statements.
